

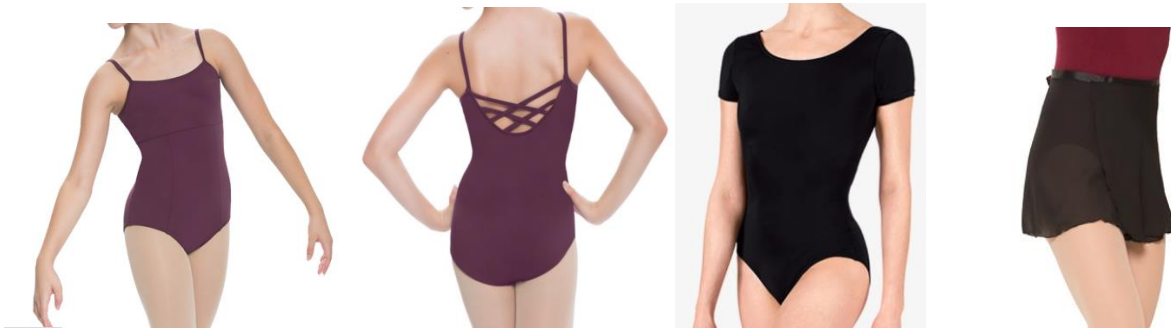
Class Dress Code

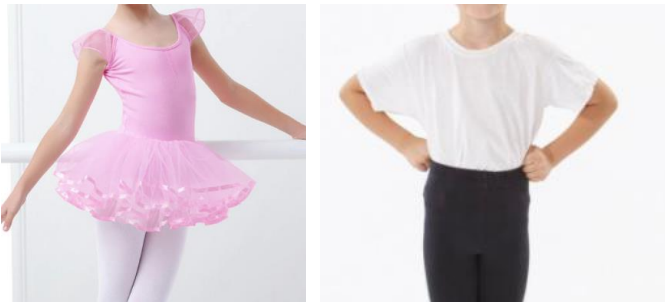
1. All Pre- ballet and Elementary Ballet 1,2,3: Lilac Leotard; Ballet tight & Shoes; White Skirt
Chinese technique level 1 and 2: Lilac Leotard; Black Shorts; White Keen; Ballet Shoes



2. Ballerina and Elementary Ballet 4: Plum and Black Leotard; Ballet tights and Shoes; Black Skirt
Technique level 3 and 4: Plum and Black Leotard; Black Shorts; White Knee Pads; Ballet Shoe



3. Creative Movements, Little Ballet Star and Princess Ballet (Dance Lesson for age 3~6)
Any type of pink ballet tutu for girl; Ballet Shoes and white/black short pans for boy; Black Ballet Shoes



4. Requirement for hair (Girl only) Female students' hair must be worn in a traditional ballet bun at the crown of the head. No bangs allowed. If a female student has short hair all hair including bangs must be clipped back and gelled away from the face. The goal is to have the hair off the neck and face to create an elegant line in a style that cannot move around.
